### Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is for senior managers who's primary responsibility within their organisation is health, safety and welfare concerns. They will lead the development and implementation of health & safety policy and systems at a strategic level, and have a working knowledge of subjects including:

# Does this qualification lead to GradIOSH?

# What is the difference between NEBOSH and the Level 7 Diploma?

NEBOSH is a qualification aimed at those who wish to gain an in-depth understanding of health and safety practice. The Level 7 Diploma is for those that already have an in-depth knowledge, are already working in a senior health and safety role and want recognition of their competence.

#### How is this qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed online with no classroom-based elements. The assessment will be primarily conducted via a series of 'professional discussions' with your assessor and involves no written work.

#### How long will this take to complete?

We provide support for a period of 12 months, however a realistic timeframe for completion of a Level 7 qualification is 2-3 months given the appropriate commitment from the learner.

#### What are the entry requirements?

No prior qualifications are required in order to apply for this qualification. Candidates will however need to already be experienced in leading the development and implementation of health & safety policy and systems at a strategic level. This will cover areas such as safety culture, sustainability, business risk, mental health, bullying & violence, biohazards, ecological risk, ergonomic hazards, and incident investigation.

Prior to enrolment candidates will be required to undertake a short profiling session with their assessor to confirm that the qualification is achievable.


